which may be included by Competent Authorities, as users of the IMI System, in application forms for registration on their Register, for the purpose of informing the applicants as to the possibility of collecting information concerning them from Competent Authorities of other member states

Within the scope of Directives 2005/36/EC and 2006/123/EC and the harmonising legislation (Law 31(I)/2008 and Law 76(I)/2010), respectively, the Council, in order to simplify the procedures and the administrative cooperation required to examine an application of a member for registration may, through the IMI System, request and receive information from the Competent Authority of another Member State concerning the applicant, in which the applicant has stated he is a registered member.

The Coordinators for the IMI System may also act as Competent Authorities and as such may send or receive requests for information.
